- Original documents must be sent to Commodity Forwarders no later than February 12,
 2014. This is in order for documents to arrive in Dubai before the shipments and complete translations for customs clearance are prepared.

**** NEW REQUIREMENT - In order to facilitate the customs clearance for the Health Authorities and prevent rummaging through your cartons, we have been asked to provide a sample box with 1 of each item that you are exhibiting at the show. This box should be labeled "FOR HIB USE". If you have only 1 chilled or Frozen item, you do not need to do this, as they will examine your whole Shipment, but if you have multiple items, we request that you make a sample box.

Necessary certification & documentation:

All shipments require certain documentation to enter United Arab Emirates. Depending on your product you may be required to provide specialized certification. Make sure your product shipment has all proper documents or certification before shipping to the consolidation warehouse.

Most **dry food items** that are packaged for retail consumption do not require anything more than commercial invoice, certificate of origin and health certificate unless they contain animal by-products or raw vegetation.

PRODUCTS COMING SPECIFICALLY FOR A FOOD SHOW ARE EXEMPT FROM DUAL LANGUAGE LABELING. THEY MAY NOT BE REQUIRED TO HAVE DATES OF PRODUCTION, BUT SHOULD HAVE AN EXPIRATION DATE. HOWEVER PRODUCTS SHOULD NOT HAVE PORK OR BY-PRODUCTS AS AN INGREDIENT, NOR PRODUCTS CONTAINING ALCOHOL AS AN INGREDIENT OR ANY BANNED COLOR/ADDITIVE. ALSO THE CARTONS SHOULD BE CLEARLY MARKED AS "SAMPLES FOR THE USA PAVILION AT GULFOOD 2014".

**** FOR PROCESSED FOODS THAT CONTAIN ANIMAL PRODUCTS (ie. eggs, cooked meats, cheese) MUST COMPLETE THE CERTIFICATE OF HEALTH AND HUMAN CONSUMPTION FORM OR SUPPLY HEALTH CERTIFICATE.

If a product contains any of the following you will have to provide:

- a) A Certificate of Origin
- b) A Phyto-sanitary Certificate (for fresh Produce, nuts, rice, bean and peas)
- c) FSIS Meat & Poultry Inspection & Certificate (9060-5) & Halal Certification
- d) Wine, spirit, beer & liquor ARE PROHIBITED.
- e) Seafood products N.O.A.A. Health Certificate or U.S. Fish & Wildlife Inspection.

Milk & Dairy products

All products of milk base (ie. Creams. Milk, cheeses, ice cream, dehydrated milks) are required to be accompanied by "CERTIFICATE OF HEALTH & HUMAN CONSUMPTION" and obtain aN Animal Health Certificate issued by Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS).

CUSTOMS NOW DEMANDS THAT ALL RETURNING FREIGHT HAVE COMPLETE DESCRIPTIONS AND ANY IDENTIFYING MARKS OR SERIAL NUMBERS ON BOTH THE INVOICE AND THE DISPLAY UNITS/EQUIPMENT.

 - 4. AIR CARRIAGE TO DUBAI AIRPORT
 - 5. FUEL & SECURITY SUR-CHARGES
 - 6. TSA SCREENING
- B) COLUMN 2 COVERS THE CHILL & FROZEN GOODS:
 - RECEIVING AND STORING PRIOR TO SHIPPING IN APPROPIATE TEMPERATURE.
 - 2. REPACKING, RECOOPING & RE-ICING FOR SHIPPING
 - 3. TRANSPORT TO JFK INT'L AIRPORT
 - 4. AIR CARRIAGE TO DUBAI AIRPORT
 - 5. FUEL & SECURITY SUR-CHARGES
 - 6. TSA SCREENING


FORMULAS

DIMENSIONAL WEIGHT = LENGTH x WIDTH x HEIGHT = CU INCHES /166 (TO THE NEAREST POUND)

You are charged on which ever weight is greater actual versus dimensional

1 KILO = 2.2046 LBS

**REMEMBER: WEIGHT CHARGES ARE BASED ON ACTUAL OR DIMENSIONAL WEIGHT (WHICHEVER IS GREATER)



THIS BOX WEIGHS 32 POUNDS. THE MEASUREMENTS ARE 28" X 20" X 16" - THIS EQUALS 8960 CU DIVIDED BY 166 = 54 LBS. THE CHARGEABLE WEIGHT IS 54 LBS
